Born in Australia Jessica trained and graduated with The Australian Ballet School. Following graduation Jessica joined The Australian Ballet Company and after 2 years was promoted to Coryfée. In 2015 Jessica was awarded the Walter Burke Scholarship to Guest perform and tour with The English National Ballet and The Stuttgart Ballet, staying on permanently with a half soloist contract in 2016 and a promotion to Soloist in 2018. Jessica danced as Etoile with National Ballet du Capitol from 2021-2023 before spending a season as a Guest Principal with Scottish Ballet where she now remains as a Principal Dancer. after success in choreographing for the 2021 season of Noverre, her grand pas de deux "Peace Apart", Jessica has commissioned to choreograph a divert for Scottish Ballet's New Nutcracker as well as a pas de deux for Scottish Ballets 24/25 Gala.
